This funding will be used to

- 95% of students in Prep-3 will be at or above regional benchmark.
- No students at a 0-3 PM reading level by the end of 2017.
- Increase our success in PAT-M and NAPLAN problem solving results by 50%
- Improve our Early Start Data from our pre- Prep students to be at benchmark by beginning of Prep year.
- Every parent to complete School Opinion Survey and have at or above 95% satisfaction rate.
- Every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an Individual Curriculum Plan) will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year-level achievement standard.

Our initiatives include

- Engage in a Reading Booster program through Sonic Learning to help provide addition instruction through game based learning to improve reading attainment.
- Fund Teacher Aide hours to increase instructional rotation time in Literacy Blocks.
- Fund Teacher Aide to help with Early Engagement in Schooling program (playgroup) and Pre-Prep transition.
- Engage the services of an experienced teacher/s or provide TRS to release a teacher to develop programs/materials to use in working with specific students on particular learning goals
- Principal to provide professional development to staff in gradually shifting responsibility to students, monitoring techniques and extending students' thinking.
- Embed the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice/action learning
- Clear and updated communication practices and opening the school during survey time to utilise the computers for submission of survey.
- Purchase of Swivl to assist staff in the observation and feedback process.
- Continue with our '5 week data discussion cycle' providing opportunities to inform the next phase of teaching and learning.
- Collaborate with students to set learning goals/targets every term to improve learner accountability and responsibility.
